3. Decorated cakes are judged on decoration only.
4. No commercial mixes or pie fillings are to be used.
5. **DO NOT** use material lid covers or paraffin wax on bottles of preserves.
6. Jars must be sealed or will be disqualified, except for freezer jams.
7. Glass containers **ONLY** for jams and pickles – with **NEW 2-piece metal lids – IF OLD LIDS ARE USED, THE ENTRY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
8. **NO PLASTIC CONTAINERS ALLOWED.**
9. The Judge holds the right to disqualify if rules and regulations are not followed. **GOOD LUCK TO ALL!**
